Wednesday, 1-27-2010 – Read Deuteronomy 10:14

A Question to Answer: Have you ever sat and stared up at the stars. Every time I get a chance to do it, I'm amazed about how big everything is. It's amazing that God created this huge universe, keeps it running, and then (with all the animals and people on this planet) loves us individually so much that he

knows how many hairs are on our heads. If we believe this about God, how can this affect our relationship to Him.

Thursday, 1-28-2010 – Read Deuteronomy 10:15-18

A Question to Answer: I like the language used here about how God "set His heart in love" on their ancestors, and how He "executes justice" for those that can't take care of themselves. God deeply adores his people. Why do you think so many people in this world feel unloved by God?

Friday, 1-29-2010 – Read Deuteronomy 10:19

My Observations: _____

A Question to Answer: Yesterday, God talked about his heart for the orphans, the widows, and strangers. Today, he says that we are to love them in the same way. God uses us to show his love, so what happens when we don't take care of those who have needs? What are some ideas that you can think of to show love for those who need to be loved?

Saturday, 1-30-2010 – Read Deuteronomy 10:20-21

My Observations: _____

A Question to Answer: Sometimes we need to be reminded of why we worship God. Sometimes we may forget just how amazing God is. In those times of pain or sorrow, in those times or worry, when we should be relying on God the most, we may forget. It says to hold fast to him, because He will take care of you. He's done it before and He'll do it again. My question is do you think the people who call themselves Believers really believe God is who is says He is and that He's going to do what He says He's going to do? And how should one's life look like who totally holds fast to the Lord and has a fear of Him. (Also, pray for the teens today for safety as we have taken them skiing this weekend)

Sunday, 1-31-2010 - Read Revelation 4 & Isaiah 6
