

MONDAY, 11/21/11 – Read Deuteronomy 8:7-10

Your Observations:

For Your Reflection: What do you love about the land in which you live? Give thanks to God today for the country and the land on which you live.

TUESDAY, 11/22/11 – Deuteronomy 8:11-18

Your Observations:

For Your Reflection: Do you consider all that you have, as a blessing from God? Give thanks to God for all that you have today – remembering that it is “not by our might” but by God’s.

WEDNESDAY, 11/23/11 – Read Psalm 65

Your Observations:

For Your Reflection: What a beautiful description of God’s bounty and beauty in creation! What is your favorite part of nature? Choose one part of nature and reflect on how God’s hand has created and sustained it.

THURSDAY, 11/24/11 – Read 2 Corinthians 9: 6-9

Your Observations:

For Your Reflection: Is it hard to be a cheerful giver? When you have been generous – have you received generosity and abundance in return?

FRIDAY, 11/25/11 – Read 2 Corinthians 9: 10-15

Your Observations:

For Your Reflection: How does the act of giving create God's ministry in this community? In what ways do you give to God's work on the Coastside? Thank God for the ability to give.

SATURDAY, 11/26/11 – Read Luke 17:11-19

Your Observations:

For Your Reflection: Has God done things for you for which you have forgotten to give thanks? Try to remember and give thanks for one forgotten blessing today.

SUNDAY, 11/27/11 – Read Luke 1:26-39

Your Observations:

For Your Reflection: Have you ever received a message from God? Would you have been able to give Mary's answer? Pray for a willing spirit this week.
